



## Draft Regulations "Performance Factor" (Pf)

### FIA memo for the attention of the Drivers

Welcome to the "Course de Côte St Jean du Gard - Col St Pierre" and thank you for participating in this round of the 2018 FIA European Hill Climb Championship.

Over the last two seasons, the FIA Hill Climb Commission has reviewed a reform of the technical regulations applicable to hill climb closed cars in Category 1 (including those in Group E1, possibly also E2-SH).

The objectives are:

- to establish a regulation that is as "open" as possible;
- to allow a greater variety of cars;
- to ensure coherence in terms of scrutineering.

In order to support this technical regulation, a new draft classification – called the "Performance Factor" (the **Pf**) – is being evaluated.

A number of reports will be published and actions will be taken at several FIA events: a series of simulations (virtual classifications based on the **Pf**) will be conducted during the 2018 season.

► In addition, **a leaflet** – outlining the **Pf** concept – will be given to you during the administrative checks.

During the "Course de Côte St Jean du Gard - Col St Pierre" event, the FIA Hill Climb Department, represented by the technical advisers Mr Gordon Forbes and Mr Jonathan Crook, and assisted by delegates from the FFSA, will contact you to present the basis of the technical project and introduce the "Performance Factor" to you.

In order to build up a database and test the car's Pf calculation, technical data (weight and certain dimensions) will also be compiled.

We ask that drivers please give the FIA technical observers access to their cars for a short time during the event.

The data will be intended solely for use by the FIA Technical Department and will not be used for regulatory purposes during the 2018 FIA competition.
